Responsibilities

- Attend events as directed by OWL's Development team.
- Use already supplied materials to promote OpenWorld Learning's mission and outcomes to people all around Denver Metro and Jefferson County.
- Assist Site Instructors at Back to School Nights and similar school events to answer parent and community member questions about OWL.
 - During Back to School Night season (late August through early September), OWL will be looking for additional hands on this as well. Back to School Night volunteers may choose to be one-off volunteers or work multiple days/nights. Training is still required.
- Promote OWL at various conventions and functions around Denver including Comicon, Stemosphere, Rotary Meetings, and so on.

How it Helps OpenWorld Learning

- OpenWorld Learning's Development team and larger staff are often spread thin amongst our many sites, keeping us from being able to network and create partnerships at a level we would consistently like to meet. Having Ambassadors to send out in our stead to promote OWL at local events would keep our staff from being too consumed by events and allow more people to hear about OWL work, potentially leading to prosperous relationships between individuals and/or organizations and OWL.

Training and Requirements

- A background check is mandatory for all OpenWorld Learning volunteers.
- An interview in which we are able to assess your relevant skills, work history, and discuss your interest in the program.
- Training on the history and mission of OWL. Volunteers should be knowledgeable enough to share basic information about the organization with interested parties.
- Reliable transportation. A car is not required but strongly preferred.

- Must be flexible and willing to attend events around Denver and Jefferson County area. Volunteers will be told of event as well in advance as possible.
